After you arrive at Kyoto Station, you may take a *bus No. 206* and get off at ‘Kumano Jinja Mae’ station. Otherwise you may take a *bus ‘hoop (KYOTO UNIVERSITY hospital loop bus)’* and get off at ‘Kyoto University Hospital’ station. The hotel will be at the corner. Both bus costs JPY 230. - The workshop will be held in Graduate School of Letters, Kyoto University.

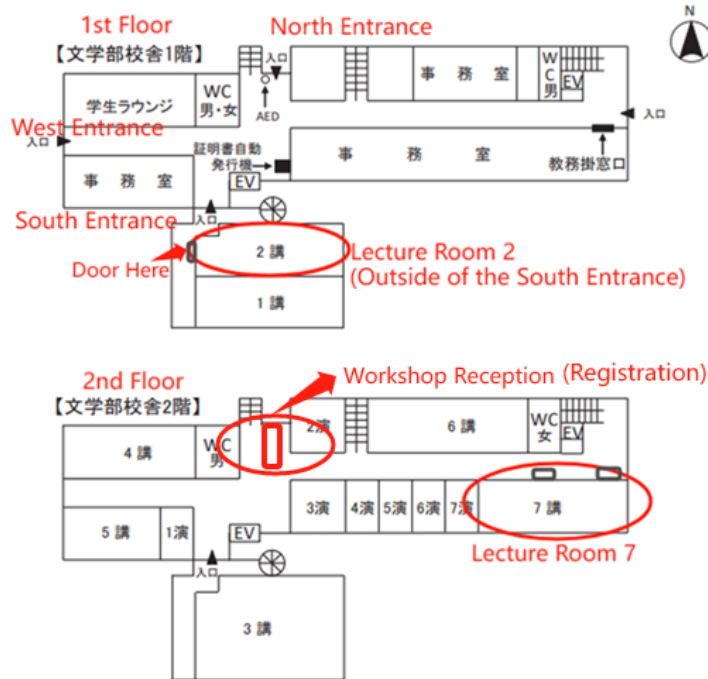
It takes an approximately 16-minutes-walk from the hotel to the place. You may check the following URL for the walking route.

- Presentations in different sessions will be carried out simultaneously in two separate classrooms, which are *Lecture Room 7* (Session 1, 3, 5, 7, also the opening statement, professors pitch talk and wrap up session) and *Lecture Room 2* (Session 2, 4, 6, 8). The reception (welcome banquet) will be at *Underground Meeting Room*.

Currency Exchange

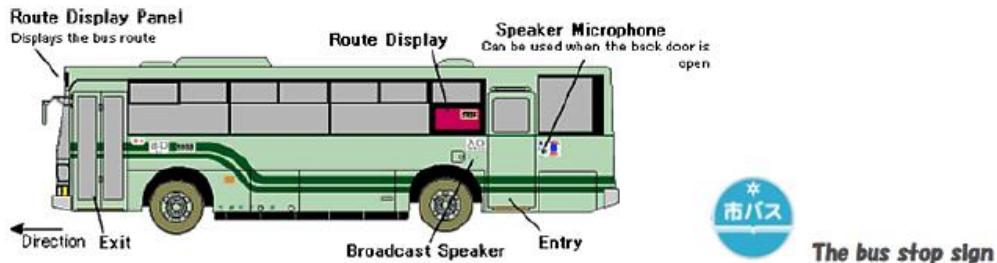

How to ride the city bus



- Please enter the bus from the back door, and exit at the front. The bus fare is paid as you get off the bus.
- To use the bus within the city centre, the fare is ¥230 for adults, and ¥120 for children (aged 6 to 12 years). The fare for traveling outside of the city center is dependent upon the distance traveled.
- Information about the route the bus will take is indicated by the bus number and main destination displayed on the front, back, and side of the bus near the door.

How to ride the bus

1. Looking at the Route Map, search for the bus number which goes from the place you are now, to the place you want to go. Determine the name of the bus stop from where you will ride, and your destination. (The route map can be found at information sites at train and subway stations)
2. Please wait at the bus stop for the bus.
3. On arrival of the bus you want to ride, enter the bus (for ticket buses, please take a ticket). The fare will depend on the number printed on the ticket.
4. When the name of your destination is announced, please press the button to stop the bus.
5. As the bus arrives at your stop, please drop your fare and ticket into the opening at the top of the payment box (1) by the side of the driver.
6. If you used a card, please enter it into the card reader (4). The fare is displayed on the chart near the exit.
